Prearranged Absences

Throughout the course of the school year, you may find that your child needs to be absent from time to time. The Buena Vista handbook states, "Buena Vista is bound by Washington State law to maintain regular attendance and punctuality records. Reasonable allowances will be made for absences and tardies, but the only state-recognized excuse for missing school is illness of the student or death in the immediate family."

Buena Vista asks that parents fill out the Pre-arranged Absence Form prior to any missed days of school in order for the absence to be excused. These forms can be found in the school office and on the Buena Vista website.

Students who go on vacation but have not submitted a Prearranged Absence Form prior to departure will have their absence listed as Unexcused. Any illness will still be considered an excused absence.



Healthy Students

In an effort to keep our students healthy, we ask that students who are sick or otherwise contagious be kept at home. If a student is running a fever, or

is suspected of being contagious by school personnel, the student must stay home until 24 hours after the fever has gone down without the aid of medication and symptoms are gone. We understand that it is an inconvenience to have your child stay home, but it really is the best choice for your child, their classmates, and school staff.
